





3. Oh no! Frost kills some spawn.



**5.** A child takes some spawn. The eggs die when kept out of the pond.


Lose 2. Move on 1


### Game steps (5)

10. An old oil can pollutes part of the pond.




#### Lose 3

12. Picnic litter thrown in the pond harms some of the froglets.






#### Lose 3

Lose 1




18. The frogs leave the pond to find new homes.
