

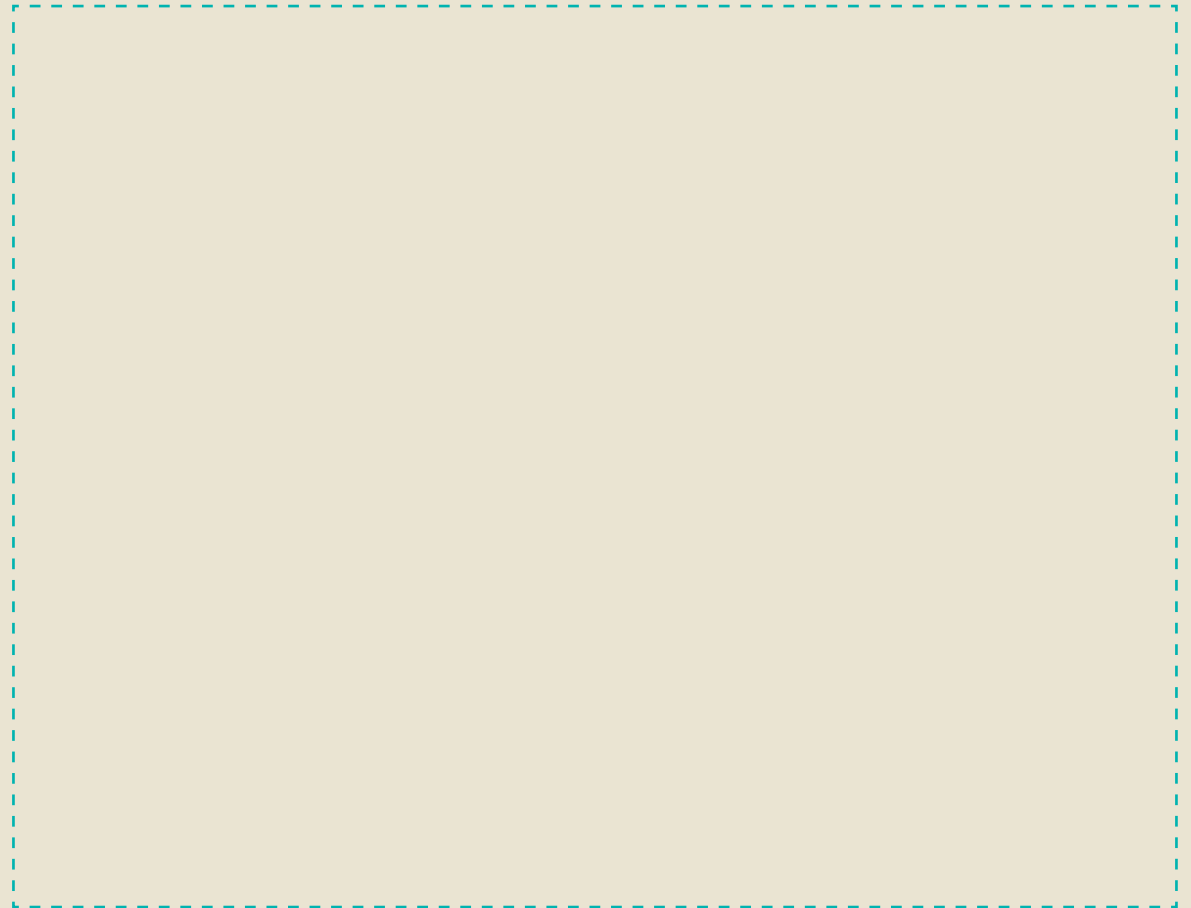

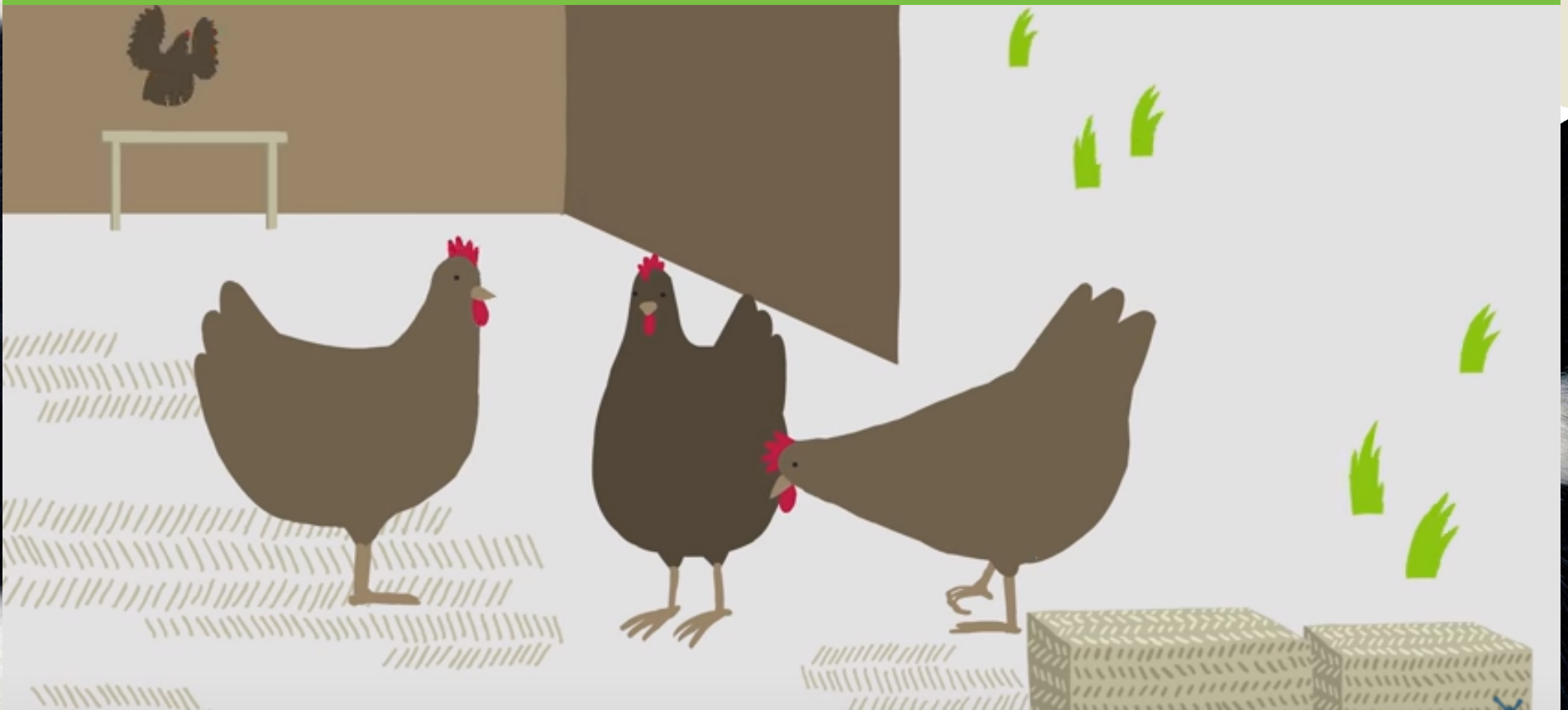

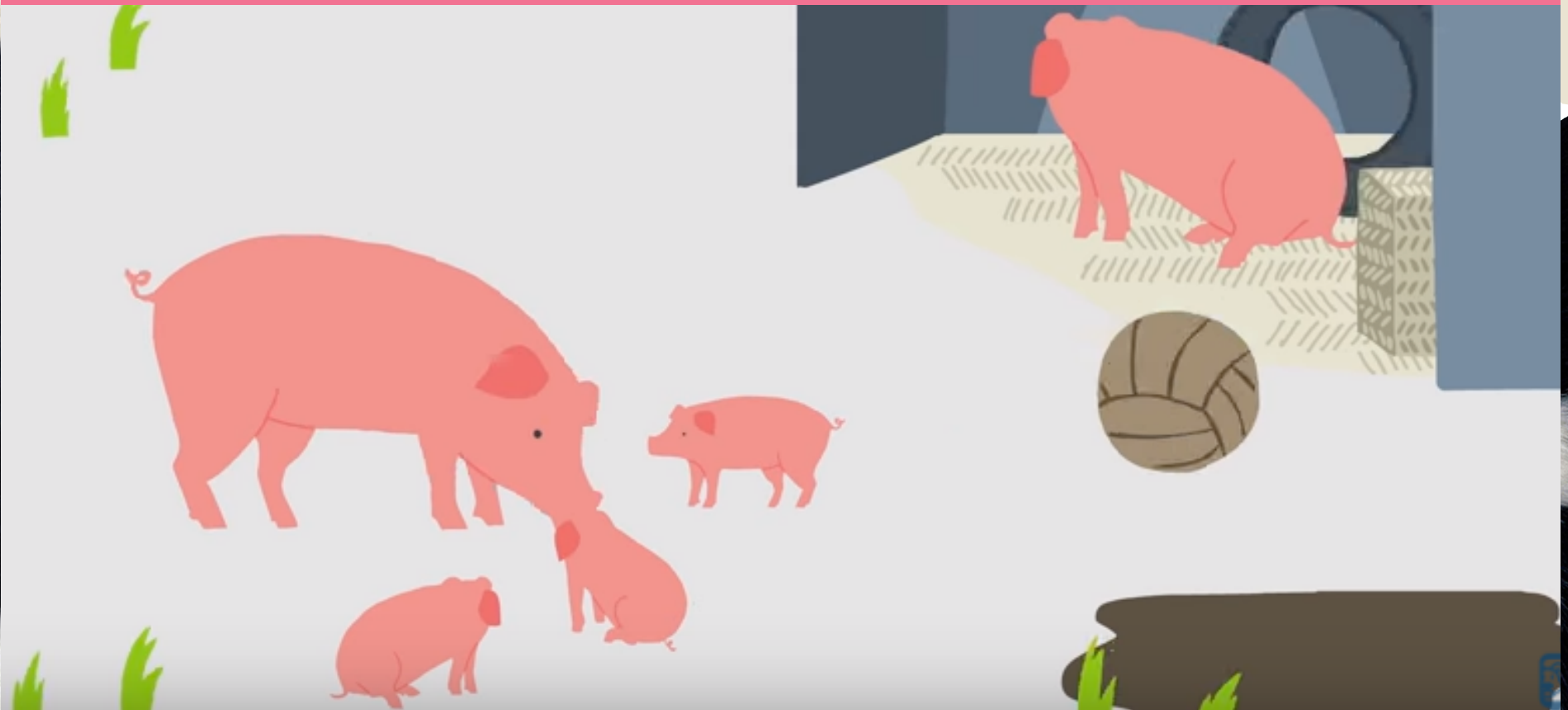

# Animal needs

## RSPCA ASSURED CHECKLIST

☐ Is there enough bedding - are the rest areas comfortable?

☐ Are the animals free to move around?

☐ Do the animals have enough space?



☐ Do the animals have shade and shelter from the weather?

☐ Is the environment enriched - does it have things to stop the animals getting bored and let them act naturally?

☐ Is it well lit?
